
OUR INCOMING STUDENTS


SELAHATTIN OTMAN, MACEDONIA ERASMUS INCOMING

BEING ELDERLY IN GERMANY

Dr. Lecturer Yasemin KAVLAK, Instructor Selda YILDIZ and Instructor Nurcan ANIK visited Dorsten Seniorenzentrum Südwall, which is an elderly care center in Germany, between 23-24 April 2018 under Erasmus+ Staff Training Mobility. Here we would like to share their experience and impression on their visit:

"During our visit to Dorsten Seniorenzentrum Südwall, we had the opportunity of observing the environment and care service offered to the elderly people and had a warm conversation with Sandra DROST, the head of the Center, about the general administrative mechanism of the Center and elderly care policy in Germany.

80 staff, 43 of whom give nursing service, deals with 82 elderly people in the Center continually as three shifts. Although there are no permanent physicians or allied health personnel in the Center except for Sandra DROST and her assistant, this type of centers are to be as far as 6 km. away from the hospitals according to German law so that these people can be transferred to the hospital in case of emergency. For the routine health care, physicians visit the Center. besides, the staff in charge of nursing service attend medical and nursing education for the first 3,5 years after being employed in the Center, pass challenging exams and have to get first aid certificate and renew the certificates every two years.

Besides our mobility in Dorsten, we also visited the village for the elderly in Mülheim, where 600 people are accommodated and all facilities such as church, supermarket, health center, activity areas are included. It is worth to visit this village for our next Erasmus mobility.

Lastly, I would like to conclude that especially the students should apply and benefit from Erasmus+ Program to observe the working area, terms of reference and responsibilities of their field of profession abroad and have an idea on different cultures, lifestyle and experience of other societies.
