
23/23 Academic year Erasmus+ Information Meeting



Assen Zlatarov University is a well-known university that was established in 1963 in the city of Burgas, which is 100 km away from Dereköy, the customs border gate of Bulgaria-Turkey and has a coast on the Black Sea. I made presentations to the students of the marketing department of the university, moderated by Assoc. Prof. Stoyan Tranev. My presentations were about the EU's Multi-Annual Financial Plan 2021-2027, which will reshape the European Union after COVID-19, and the EU's Digital Union goals.
